



As part of our Lasallian tradition, the 11th day of the General Chapter began at 9:00 a.m. with the "Live Jesus in our hearts! Forever!", pronounced by Brother Jorge A. Sierra, Coordinator. This was followed by the opening prayer in French, led by Brother Louis Mjalli.

After the welcoming words, the Coordinator announced the agenda of this last day of the second phase of the General Chapter: "Boldness in truth".

The morning of this day was dedicated to the specification of the challenges and dreams, and to move to the process of truth. During this day, an important part was dedicated to prayer (personal retreat). We were invited to meditate on the image of leaven mentioned yesterday, as the leaven of a new world.

After the presentation of the revised schedule, the meeting moved on to the first item on the agenda, which was the identification of values by Region, followed by sharing.

From the values found by Region, we can retain the following:

- 1. RELEM: interiority, solidarity, audacity, culture of encounter.
- 2. RELAL: audacity, integral ecological commitment and authenticity.
- 3. RELAN: vulnerability, **audacity** and perseverance.
- 4. RELAF: **solidarity**, hospitality and conversion.
- 5. PARC: audacity, justice and communion.

Two common words found in all Regions emerged from this sharing: 1. **audacity,** 2. **solidarity.**









After a long time to share on the scale of values, the assembly started with the vote that gave the following scale of values:

- 1. Prophetic Audacity
- 2. Solidarity
- 3. Interiority
- 4. Culture of the meeting
- 5. Integral ecological commitment.

Upon returning from this morning's break, the guidelines for the personal retreat (The Conversion Journey) were given by Sister Leslie.

For the afternoon session, at 3:00 pm, all the participants met in linguistic groups for sharing. All of us met again in the Aula Magna at 5:00 p.m. to share. It should be noted that this was preceded by the vote on act 7.

Voting on six conversion processes and results: French-speaking group 1 and 2, Spanish-speaking group 1 and 2. Due to the time for the mass which was said by an Archbishop, the session was closed at 6:29 p.m. postponing the vote of the conversion processes to the next day, Thursday, May 12.

I was personally struck by the quality of the work of this tenth day. The time of personal retreat that we had in the midst of our General Chapter was a pause, a time of grace, and also an opportunity for a little introspection.

May God, through the intercession of St. John Baptist de La Salle, continue to bless the proceedings of this 46th General Chapter.
