Day 13

The Generalate in Rome remained silent for most of the day. It is not that the Capitulants left the House during this day, but the work was focused on the discussions of the seven groups which were formed and which will be responsible for the concretisation of the Pathways of Transformation (decisions).

This work was interesting and challenging. The groups are made up of people from all Regions, regardless of language. Discussions are deep and a few times the team of translators was called upon to “lend a helping hand” to the groups in order to get out of the holes that sometimes arise due to language and cultural differences that make it difficult for a word to fit in everyone’s understanding.

At lunchtime, the sound returned to the corridors and at lunchtime it was brightened by the celebration of Brother David Hawke’s birthday.

As the sun gave way to night in the Eternal City, the Capitulants joined other Lasallians from Rome at the Sanctuary of St. John Baptist de La Salle. They listened to the voices of the choir of the Istituto “*La Salle*” Pio IX Aventino. It was an exciting evening of beautiful music and lovely voices, as well as the surround sound of the Sanctuary’s organ. At times the twilight turned this tribute from the District of Italy into a real moment of prayer for peace. One of the last songs was a lullaby of Ukrainian origin.
